throughout the summer. In order to accomplish our program, preschoolers are encouraged to read as many books as possible, K-3 grades 15 books, and 4 -6 grades 10 books. All children are also encouraged to read at least three

Pagers

Dulin has purchased a new paging system for our nursery. The system will be in place on June 7th. The system is put out by JTech communications and will function similarly to the last system. The pagers will light up and vibrate if a parent is needed in the nursery.

New to this system is that, if the pager is taken off site it

will beep. In order to stop the pager from beeping, it must be returned to the church. So, please be sure to return the pagers when you pick up your child from the nursery.
