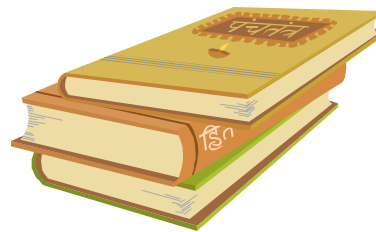
## Summer of Reading Redux
